

**TOWN OF MINONG
OFFENSES AGAINST STATE LAW
ORDINANCE 2024-37**

The Town of Minong, Washburn County, ordains as follows:

SECTION I – STATE LAWS ADOPTED

The following statutes defining offenses against the peace and good order of the state are adopted by reference to define offenses against the peace and good order of the town. The prosecution of such offenses under this section shall be provided in Wis. Statutes and the penalty for violation thereof shall be limited to forfeiture as hereinafter provided in this chapter. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications to the statutes incorporated herein by reference are intended to be made part of this Code.

SECTION II – STATUTES SPECIFICALLY INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE

Whenever this chapter incorporates by reference specific sections of the state statutes, such references shall mean the Wisconsin Statutes of 2024 as from time to time amended, repealed or modified by the state legislature.

SECTION IV – CITATIONS AND FORFEITURES

The penalty for violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance is \$100.00 for the first offence, \$150.00 for the second offence, and \$200.00 for the third offence.

SECTION V – EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law, heretofore enacted by the Town of Minong.
